

Care & Maintenance Guide for Handles

Inspection and Maintenance

Inspection and maintenance of all Momo Handles products must be carried out at appropriate intervals, which is generally every 12 months. For products located in high traffic areas or harsh environmental conditions, inspection and maintenance should be conducted at 6 monthly intervals. In extreme conditions, an inspection every 3 months is recommended.

Our recommended inspection & maintenance procedures for our solid brass ranges are listed below. For other product ranges, please enquire. Please note that regular inspection & maintenance may not necessarily prevent deterioration over time.

Deterioration caused by improper installation or failure to follow fitting instructions, failure due to improper maintenance or maltreatment, general wear and tear, or environmental conditions is not covered by warranty. During installation, care should be taken to ensure that products are protected from exposure to building materials such as paint, thinners, mortar, stone dust etc.

Care of finishes

Particular care should be taken to clean and maintain surface finishes, as many finishes may be damaged by incorrect cleaning.

Frequent wiping using a soft, dry microfibre cloth is recommended, do not use a wet cloth. If the handles become wet or moist at any time, it should be immediately removed, and the handles dried completely. No type of chemical or abrasive cleaner should be used at any time and use of such products will void any warranties or guarantees applicable. Special care should be taken during construction, installation and cleaning to ensure that handles are protected from any chemicals or abrasive products.

Natural ageing of some finishes is a feature of the product and is not considered a defect. If the finish becomes wet or damp for any reason, immediately dry thoroughly with a microfibre cloth. Allowing water to remain on the surface may lead to permanent staining or discolouration.

Anodized aluminium – maintain by wiping with dry microfibre cloth.

Bronze - maintain by wiping with dry microfibre cloth.

Electro-plated – maintain by wiping with dry microfibre cloth.

Lacquered & unlacquered solid brass - maintain by wiping with dry microfibre cloth.

Nickel & Chrome plated - maintain by wiping with dry microfibre cloth.

Nylon - maintain by wiping with dry microfibre cloth.

Stainless steel – maintain by wiping with dry microfibre cloth.

Unlacquered brass - maintain by wiping with dry microfibre cloth.
